

Camp Rules

Because we want to be sure you have a pleasant, enjoyable holiday at Pacific Park Christian Holiday Camp we ask everyone to keep the following rules. The co-operation of ALL campers is very important so that everyone who stays at the Park will benefit.

- Arrival times:** Motel, Cabin, Camp Ground -- After 2:00pm
Lodges -- After 4:00pm
- Departure time:** By 10:00am
- Accounts:** Balances of accounts are payable upon arrival
Payment must be for full time booked
No refund on early departures
Breakages or other damage must be reported to office and cost of repair will be charged to the person responsible
- Caravans/Tents:** Must have a current electrical warrant of fitness
Smoke detectors are highly recommended as they do save lives
Wastewater must be caught and emptied at designated disposal points
Tents requiring power must have an isolating transformer
- Children:** To be controlled and under parental supervision when using facilities
The Dept of Labour recommends No Children under 9 years to use top bunks
- Conduct:** Complete quietness between 10:30p.m. - 7:00a.m.
Reasonable behavior and dress at all times
All areas on camp grounds are smoke free
No alcohol or drugs anywhere on the premises
- Kitchen:** Please keep tidy for the benefit of others
- Laundry:** \$3.00 for Washing & Dryers per load. (\$1 & \$2 coin required)
Washing powder available at the office for \$1 per sachet
- Pets:** Sorry! Animals not permitted
- Pool:** Open 5pm -9pm daily
No lifeguard is on duty at any time
Children 14yrs and under must be supervised in the pool
Proper swimwear is required in the pool
- Recycling:** Please place all plastic bottles, glass & cans in the recycle bins provided
- Showers:** 50c coin for five minute showers
- Vehicles:** Speed not to exceed walking pace at all times
Only one vehicle can be parked on your own site
Do not park on driveways or other sites, empty or not!
The gate may be locked from 10:30pm – 7:30am
If travelling early, please park cars on roadside of gate
- Visitors:** All visitors must leave their vehicles on front grassed area and report to office on arrival
Day Visitors: \$1.00 per person
Visitors must leave the camp by 10:00pm
Visitors staying overnight must have the consent of the Management and pay the usual camp fees. The site holder is responsible for any unpaid fees
- Respect:** Showing respect for other guest, for the neighbours, and for the camp property, is the key for a happy stay for all. Please consider others in all you do.
